

INKATERRA's Denise Guislain Koechlin is recognized as one of the best hotel interior designers in the world

In the January 2011 issue of Condé Nast Traveller, UK, Inkaterra La Casona was recognized as one of the best hotels in the world in the category 'Ambience and Design,' as part of the magazine's influential annual Gold List. Highlighted with a blue 'Editor's Pick' seal, the Denise Guislain Koechlindesigned hotel was one of only three award-winning properties in the Americas and the Caribbean.

Condé Nast Traveller makes special mention that Inkaterra La Casona, Peru's only Relais & Chateaux property, was designed by Guislain Koechlin, who personally directed the restoration and redesign of the property. The resulting product echoes the original colonial Peruvian home—which dates back to 1534 and its original incarnation as the home of Diego de Almagro, conqueror of Chile, and later of Simon Bolivar--while retaining its historic integrity and adding such contemporary touches as under-floor heating, deep Roman soaking tubs and the latest gadgetry in each of the 11 beautiful suites. The dining room also receives a special mention in the issue for both its ambiance and traditional Peruvian cuisine.
