As part of the commitment to the research for conservation at the Amazonian forests of the Tambopata region, ITA and the Forestry Sciences Faculty of the Universidad Nacional Agraria La Molina (FCF – UNALM) have finished the assessment of the floristic composition of the Medicinal Plants Garden and of the Shimbillo Trail, both at Hacienda Concepción. This research work has been done by a team of students of the FCF – UNALM who are part of ITA's Volunteer Program focused in the formation of young researchers. The improvement of the tree nursery at the Chacra Gamitana Farm has been done by this group as well, as part of their activities to encourage reforestation activities at ITA's work areas.
