

The Earth Hour at the Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel

The Earth Hour, is an international event promoted by the **WWF**-World Wife Fund for Nature (World Fund for the Nature), the consists of a **"voluntary blackout"**, the Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel joined this cause, putting out its lights by the space of an hour (8:30-9:30 pm.), and lighted with candles its access roads to the rooms, reception, lobby, bar, restaurants, spa and the ecotourism office. According to the organizers, the reduction in the energy consumption contributes to diminish carbon dioxide emissions (CO²).
