3 PRIVATE ISLANDS

When Kate and Wills needed to book their honeymoon, the only destination secure and impenetrable enough was the remote North Island in the Seychelles. This year sees the launch of a handful of other exclusive island retreats. The 27 stilted eco-villas at Song Saa, the first island resort in Cambodia, are located on the lovely Koh Rong archipelago, with pristine rainforest and reefs to explore. Ariara is a private-island resort in the Philippines and sleeps up to 18. In the Maldives, Coco Palm Kuda Hithi is an exclusive-use haven that sleeps 12 and costs just under £30,000 a night; you have exclusive use of dive and yacht staff, spa and butlers. In the Caribbean, the much-loved Petit Saint Vincent island resort, with two miles of white-sand beach, is under new management; new facilities include a kids' club, yoga hut and casual feet-in-the-sand restaurant. 

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
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
