Where to Get High: 10 Luxury Resorts with the Best Sky-High Views

Vertigo has never been so much fun. Whether you're gazing down on an Alaskan glacier, on the Amazonian rain forest or on colorful fish swimming around a coral reef in the Maldives, the world looks different—often better—from above.

While a stunning view straight out over a city- or seascape has long been a selling point for luxury hotels and resorts, forward doesn't have to be the only way to focus. These ten resorts (some of which have hosted me as a writer) think vertically.



The Canopy Walk at Inkaterra Reserve Amazonica

Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica, Peru

All 35 cabanas at this [eco-chic resort](#) fronting the Amazon River are perfectly lovely. But the most dramatic is the Canopy Tree House, which is properly built in a tree and reached by a long suspension bridge that hangs 98 feet above the rain forest floor. Guests who don't book the tree house can still take a motorized canoe down the river to reach the Canopy Walk, a system of eight suspension bridges over the jungle canopy that includes this view.
