INKATERRA RESERVA AMAZóNICA Tambopata, Peru

There's one room that soars high above the rest at this collection of eco-friendly cabins situated on the banks of the Madre de Dios River, a feeder of the Amazon, deep in the jungle of southern Peru. The Canopy Tree House sits 90 feet above the ground and is accessible only via a wooden canopy walk. The cabin itself is quite basic with limited water and electricity, but the bed is ultra plush and ensconced in a romantic mosquito net. And butler service is standard, as are bespoke pisco sours, a romantic dinner and a private guided evening excursion across the treetops.

Room rates start at \$880 a night and are all inclusive, inkaterra.com
