# INKATERRA CANOPY TREE HOUSE

## DESCRIPTION

For a truly unforgettable rainforest experience, Inkaterra's Canopy Tree House offers complete seclusion in the heart of the southeastern Peruvian Amazon. Set on a private platform and connected to the iconic Inkaterra Canopy Walkway—rising 92 feet (28 meters) above the forest floor—this unique retreat promises exceptional service and an immersive jungle stay like no other. From this remarkable vantage point high in the canopy, guests can observe a variety of wildlife rarely seen from the ground and soak in the vibrant sounds of the rainforest while enjoying refreshing drinks. As night falls, a charming open-air dinner awaits, followed by a guided night walk revealing the hidden wonders of the rainforest.





## FACILITIES

The Canopy Tree House is located on the most remote platform of the Inkaterra Canopy Walkway, connected by a hanging bridge to another tower, and standing 92 feet (28 meters) above the forest floor.

Inspired by the traditional architecture of the Ese' Eja culture, the Canopy Tree House reflects the distinctive style of Inkaterra Reserva Amazónica, with palm-thatched roofs and wooden floors that blend harmoniously with the surrounding natural environment.

This enchanting treehouse features two beds, a lavatory, a portable toilet, and windows with removable mosquito netting —perfect for birdwatching and fully immersing yourself in the beauty of the rainforest. It also includes a drop-leaf table and wooden folding chairs.

For added comfort, guests are provided with flashlights, as well as umbrellas and ponchos for rainy days.



## THE EXPERIENCE

At the end of the day's activities, guests will meet their private Explorer Guide and embark on a short boat ride to the Inkaterra Canopy Walkway, home to the Canopy Tree House. Upon arrival at the Canopy Interpretation Center, they will be welcomed by an assistant who will help with their luggage and escort them to their treehouse. From this unique vantage point, guests will have the opportunity to spot various bird species and take in exceptional views. The walkway spans more than 1,130 feet (344 meters), allowing guests to explore an extensive network of treetop paths connected by suspension bridges, linking eight observation platforms and two high towers standing 138 feet (42 meters) tall.

From these impressive towers, guests can enjoy a "sundowner"—a sunset cocktail accompanied by a selection of snacks, soft drinks, or even a chilled bottle of wine or sparkling cava to celebrate a special occasion. As night falls, under a starry sky and the light of the moon, they will savor an open-air dinner before setting off on a nighttime walk through the treetops, crossing the hanging bridges of the Inkaterra Canopy Walkway.

After this unforgettable treetop adventure, guests may choose to spend the night in the treehouse or return to the comfort of their cozy lodge cabin. At sunrise, they will be invited to rise early for a one-of-a-kind excursion through the lush rainforest, exploring its rich flora and fauna, before enjoying a delicious breakfast.

## INCLUDED SERVICES:



### **Sundowner:**

As the sun begins to set, unwind on one of the Inkaterra Canopy platforms with a bottle of wine or cava, accompanied by a selection of exquisite bites.



### **In-Room Dinner:**

Enjoy a light dinner of your choice, part of a specially curated menu thoughtfully crafted for life in the Amazon.



### **Breakfast:**

Start your day with a delightful breakfast. Guests will be asked to select their breakfast preference the night before.



### **24-Hour Canopy Bar Service:**

The treehouse is equipped with a cooler stocked with a selection of beverages and chilled bottled water, available for guests to enjoy at any time.

## TREE HOUSE AMENITIES AND ECO CONSIDERATIONS:

- **Head lamp:** Available in the Canopy Tree House.
- **Walkie Talkies:** A set of walkie talkies is provided in the treehouse for direct communication with the canopy assistant or the Explorer Guide throughout your stay.
- **Whistle:** Available in the treehouse. In case of any emergencies, guests can use the whistle to alert the Explorer Guide or assistant, who are available to assist at any time.
- **Umbrellas:** Available upon request
- **Emergency evacuation procedures:** Located in the Canopy Tree House.
- **First aid kit:** Available upon request
- **Waterproof Curtain:** Bamboo curtains that can be unrolled during rain.
- **Binoculars:** Available in the Canopy Tree House.
- **John O'Neil's "Birds of Peru" guide:** Available in the treehouse. This award-winning guide helps travelers identify various bird species. It is also available for purchase upon request at the lodge.
- **Bird check list:** A printed list of bird species sighted at Inkaterra Reserva Amazónica.
- **Citronella splash:** A natural product made from citronella essence, free from chemicals that could impact the fragile canopy ecosystem.
- **Hand-held fan:** Made by the native Ese' Eja community using recycled local materials like PET and Tamishi.
- **Rain ponchos:** Available in the Canopy Tree House.
- **Paper pad and pencil:** Provided in the Canopy Tree House
