


## For adrenaline junkies >>>

Hemmed by jagged Andean peaks and crisscrossed by rushing rivers, Peru's Sacred Valley lures adventurers with its horseback riding, four-wheeling,

white-water rafting, rappelling and cycling. Recover at the art-filled Relais & Chateau Sol & Luna Lodge, where a soak in your casita's outdoor tub and a Reiki treatment at the mosaic-walled spa will have you ready to hang glide with the hotel's owner in no time flat. From \$240.

For surf seekers >> If you've conquered the waves at Waikiki and Sayulita, it's time for a visit to Mancora, a sweet surf spot located just a few hours from the Ecuadoran border and known for year-round swells and a funky vibe. Rest your board

at KiChic, a seven-villa hotel where honeymoon packages include a couples yoga lesson and a beachside massage. From \$200.

For fearless foodies >> Peru's diversity of native foods is legendary (hello, more than 4,000 varieties of potato!), and adventurous chefs in Lima are turning tradition on its head, utilizing meats like alpaca and piranha and native fruits like lucuma. Chef Virgilio Martinez's spot, Central, boasts a 17-course tasting menu that guides diners through a gastronomic tour of the country.

## For animal aficionados >>>

Deep within the Amazon basin, Peru's Tambopata National Reserve creeps, crawls, swims and flies with wildlife of every ilk. Giant anteaters wander the riverbanks, monkeys swing from the trees, and jaguars lurk in the dense forest. Take it all in with a dose of low-impact luxury at Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica.
