discovering the world's largest collection of native orchids - some 372 species - in their natural habitat (a world record according to the AOS), star gazing at the *Rocotal* Observatory, a purification session in the property's Andean Sauna, and, of course, visiting Machu Picchu, one of the new 7 Wonders of the World.

Travelers then head to the Sacred Valley of the Incas for a two-night stay at the recently opened and already award-winning Inkaterra Hacienda Urubamba. On-site, guests can pick their own produce from the property's ecological farm, relax in their luxury rooms with panoramic views of the surrounding mountains, and sample the property's activities such as bird watching and a twilight walk. Guests will also visit various historical sites off-site such as Chinchero (Inca-Colonial village), Maras (Inca pink salt mine) and Moray (Inca circular terraces).
