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Positioned next to the verdant Tambopata National Reserve on the banks of the Madre de Dios river, Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica is the creation of conservationist, filmmaker and entrepreneur José. Koechlin. Since its inception in 1978, the resort has been instrumental in advancing scientific research, conducting studies and cataloging endemic flora, fauna and wildlife, and the proudly carbon neutral property sits lightly on 25,000 acres of virgin rain forest, thereby protecting the land from deforestation. Tour the 100ft-high Inkaterra Canopy Walkway, a system of hanging bridges built by the Inkaterra Asociación to observe Amazonian wildlife. Following a day exploring with one of the local guides, seek sanctuary under the fishtail-palm roof of the private terrace in the Tambopota Suite, where you'll find a plunge pool and an expansive chill-out area. Ralax in a hammock in the siesta lounge, listening to the meditative sounds of the jungle.
