

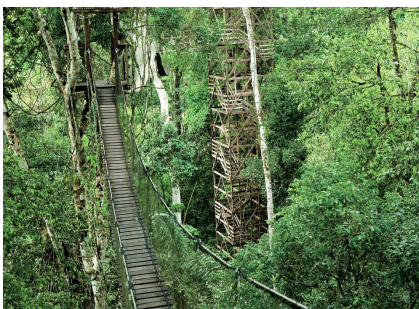

9 Tree House Hotels We'd Love to Call Home

Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica, Puerto Maldonado, Peru

Getting to Inkaterra's jungle **outpost** involves three flights (to Lima, Cusco and Puerto Maldonado) and a 30-minute boat ride on the Madre de Dios River, but the effort is repaid tenfold with once-in-a-lifetime wildlife encounters, expert-led jungle walks and romantic accommodations. The jewel in the already weighty crown is the Canopy Treehouse, set on the highest and most remote platform of the 1,130-foot Canopy Walkway. A butler is on hand to help with bags, sundowners and light meals, but guests are otherwise completely alone among the numberless bird, animal and insect species.

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
