Orchid Species Discovered at Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel

Recently discovered at the Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel, an orchid species from the genus Epidendrum has been described as new to science by biologist Eric Hágsater (Herbario AMO, Mexico) and Carmen Soto (Inkaterra Asociación).

With the full name Epidendrum guislainae, it is the 21st orchid species discovered at Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel and is one of more than 350 species that are part of the world's largest native orchid collection, according to the American Orchid Society. The newly discovered orchid was named after Denise Guislain, the award-winning chief of architecture and interior design at Inkaterra.

Inkaterra's dedication to biology and conservation dates to 1976 when Inkaterra founder & CEO José Koechlin acquired ten hectares in Machu Picchu Pueblo facing the Vilcanota River.

Originally used as a sawmill, with pasture ravaged by cattle and a tea plantation, Inkaterra started restoring the damaged land in 1980 aiming to repair the ecosystem, including recovery of a proper habitat for the Andean cock-of-the-rock, considered Peru's national bird. Since

then, Inkaterra has registered 214 bird species, 111 butterfly species and 373 orchid species – with two dozen different species of fauna and flora – all within the grounds of the Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel.

In 2001, Inkaterra founded the Andean Bear Conservation Center. Since the Andean bear is threatened and considered an umbrella species in different ecosystems in South America, the center rehabilitates bears found in inadequate captivity conditions, such as circuses and zoos. So far, five bears have been rescued, with four currently being rehabilitated and one successfully returned to the wild.






