Inkaterra La Casona, Cusco, Peru

Inkaterra La Casona is a 16th century manor house that has been restored in keeping with the original architectural details. Beyond returning the architecture to its former glory, including frescoes from when Spanish Conquistador Simon Bolivar resided here, Inkaterra has added original artwork to further enhance the atmosphere. Inkaterra La Casona is Cusco's first boutique hotel and is set on the former "training grounds for an elite army of Incas." The property has 11 suites, many of which overlook the patio.
