

These globetrotting adventures are full-on cultural immersions and educational experiences — promising kids and teens new lifelong skills.

Angama Mara, Kenya

Luxury African safari camps offer lasting memories and wildlife sightings, and the unique lodging and valuable insights into environmental preservation of Angama Mara is no different. Located on the edge of Kenya's Oloololo Escarpment above the Maasai Mara, Angama Mara delivers the ultimate adventure for children with activities, including fishing,

frogging and tadpooling in the dam; bugging and tracking on nature walks with Maasai guides; learning the art of spear throwing from a Maasai warrior; and visiting local schools. They can also meet with the resort's "Maasai Mamas" in the property's beading studio or study nature photography at the resort's professional photo studio. Angama Mara's on-site wildlife photographer teaches guests, including kids and teens, how to use their own cameras in a professional setting and spend some time editing, retouching, color-correcting and perfecting wildlife photos.

Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo Hotel, Peru

Inkaterra is much more than a posh resort near Machu Picchu. It is an intimate Andean village with terraced hills, waterfalls, stone pathways and 81 whitewashed adobe casitas tucked away in the cloud forest. In this setting, the Inkaterra team starts kids' adventures with an Explorer Kit consisting of a flashlight, cap, colored pencils, magnifying glass and more. These are the basic tools they can use while participating in such programs as being a guide assistant during an excursion for a day or doing a treasure hunt, incorporating fun and educational tasks such as riddles, handicrafts, drawings and research of the fauna and flora of the region. Children can also learn about the 372 different varieties of orchids on property, visit the spectacled bear project and learn how to make tea bags.
