STRANDHOTEL KURHAUS JUIST: DINE IN THE HISTORIC DINING ROOM



Fortunately, today it shines again in old splendor and pampers you with luxurious and historical charm – whether in the spa or in the glass dome, from which you can overlook the entire island, or in the stately-looking white hall, in which you can relax and feel transported back into the old days!


