Seaside sustainability in Cornwall

Perched upon a cliff top in north Cornwall, The Scarlet is one of the UK's best eco escapes. The glass structured building - where Dawn French got married - offers farreaching views of the beach from wherever you are in the hotel. You can enjoy all sorts of natural

amenities, including the cliff-side log hot tubs, a natural reedbed swimming pool and the Ayurveda holistic spa, which

offers an upcycling towel program where old towels are made into sleep masks and scrub mitts. The hotel has 111 sustainable measures to ensure they improve their green commitment, such as solar panels, locally sourced food for the restaurants and biomass boilers, which use wood pellets instead of gas or oil.
