Titilaka

Located on the shores of Lake Titicaca, considered sacred by the Incas as the cradle of human civilization, Titilaka is a modern, eco-friendly, and welcoming hotel.

With services such as a driver, speedboat, and private tour guide who prepares personalized archaeological tours, kayaking excursions, and dinners featuring fresh fish, the hotel surprises and offers a cultural immersion in Peruvian tradition with great comfort.

Cirqa

Arequipa is the second largest city in Peru. Steeped in history and culture, it has much to offer, especially when it comes to luxury accommodations.

Cirqa is a luxurious hotel located in the historic center of Arequipa, a UNESCO World Heritage site, transporting guests to another era. Tambo del Inka

Located at the foot of the Chicón mountain in the Sacred Valley of the Incas, Tambo is the only resort in the region with a private train station providing access to Machu Picchu.

Among its other unique features, it also has an indoor pool, rooms with views of the Andes Mountains, Inca therapeutic treatments at the Kallpa Spa, and a restaurant that serves authentic Andean cuisine with organic ingredients from its own garden.

Las Casitas, A Belmond Hotel

It was difficult to select just one among the five **Belmond** hotels recognized by the Michelin Keys. Specializing in luxury hotels, trains, river cruises, and safaris, the Belmond chain knows how to create premium experiences. With the Las Casitas hotel, the chain received three Michelin keys, the highest recognition of the award.

At Belmond Las Casitas, there's no contradiction between adventure and luxury. It's located in the Colca Valley, one of Peru's natural wonders, featuring farms, active volcanoes, and a canyon larger than the Grand Canyon. Amenities include a range of outdoor activities as well as the traditional options of a 5-star hotel, such as spa treatments.

However, as we mentioned, it's worth exploring the other award-winning hotels in the chain in Peru: **Miraflores Park** in Lima, **Monasterio** and **Palacio Nazarenas**, both in Cusco, and **Rio Sagrado** in Urubamba, Ollantaytambo, Sacred Valley.

Inkaterra Hacienda Urubamba

Just like with the Belmond chain, it was difficult to choose just one among the Michelin-starred hotels from the **Inkaterra** network, a Peruvian organization that offers sustainable tourism initiatives.

Hacienda Urubamba is located in the Sacred Valley of the Incas and makes it clear that it is possible to live luxuriously while remaining sustainable.

Among the amenities are tasteful décor featuring local crafts, views of the Andes, heated floors, and a spectacular "from the land to the table" restaurant showcasing the best of Peruvian cuisine. There's also a spa with natural regional products, and it's possible to book cooking classes, wine tastings, and ancestral ceremonies.
